- photos should be in **jpg** format and of a size that is suitable for printing
- photos should be free to use by the ICF, **clear of any copyright claims** (if you are not sure of any third-party interests, please do not submit the photo(s) in question)
- a short **description of no more than 200 words** for each photo about the event, person, story etc. that is shown in the image
- the photos can be about anything of interest from our sport: historical equipment, interesting locations, exciting moments at major events, iconic athletes etc.
- photos can be **black&white or colour**
- historical significance is a trade-off for quality for obvious reason, so please do not hesitate to send (very) old photos if considered to depict a memorable moment, no matter how bad quality seems at first
